- Bible
- Paper

- Bread or crackers

THIS WEEK'S ACTIVITIES:

A Special Place: Kids will create a special place to spend time with God.

At-Home Tabernacle: Kids will make their own version of the Tabernacle using blankets and furniture.

Some Things Don't Mix: Kids will learn how God and sin can't go together by using several spices and a cup of water.

A SPECIAL PLACE

Create a space in your house that's a "holy" (set apart) place to spend time with God. A blanket fort could be a fun idea! Make sure to include a Bible in your special place and spend time with God together as a family.

- what is one thing that amazes you about God?



AT HOME TABERNACLE:

SUPPLIES:

- Blankets
- Furniture
- Clothes Pins or something to Secure the Blankets

Create a Indoor Tabernacle using blankets, chairs, furniture, and what else you have in your home. Inside the Tabernacle place an inner curtain or wall to represent the inner curtain. This will make your tabernacle have two rooms. One room for you and one room made especially for God!



SOME THINGS JUST DON'T MIX

SUPPLIES:

- Finely Ground Salt
- Sugar
- Powdered Cornstarch
- Ground Cinnamon
- Ground Black Pepper
- Ground Nutmeg
- Cup or Bowl of Water
- Spoons

Step 1: Have kids gather around the bowl or cup of water.

Step 2: Going through each spice or seasoning, have kids vote on whether or not they think their ingredient will dissolve in the water (will it mix in to the water so that you can't see it anymore.)

Step 3: After kids have voted, sprinkle the ingredient into the water and take turns stirring. Watch to see if the ingredient will dissolve.

Step 4: Continue this process, getting new water as necessary, until all ingredients have been tested.

Discuss:

Some things just don't mix, as certain ingredients didn't mix in and was separate from the water, our sin keeps us separated from God. But God, couldn't let that happen, so he sent Jesus so we can live with God! God loves us so much!
